Guidance notes

You are required to remain on the register if you are currently teaching in:

- a maintained school,
- a non-maintained special school,
- a pupil referral unit.

This includes part-time, temporary and supply teachers

Exemptions from the requirement to remain registered include:

- teachers working as home tutors
- teachers working in outdoor education centres
- teachers working in the independent sector or in further or higher education
- qualified teachers in non-maintained nursery schools.
